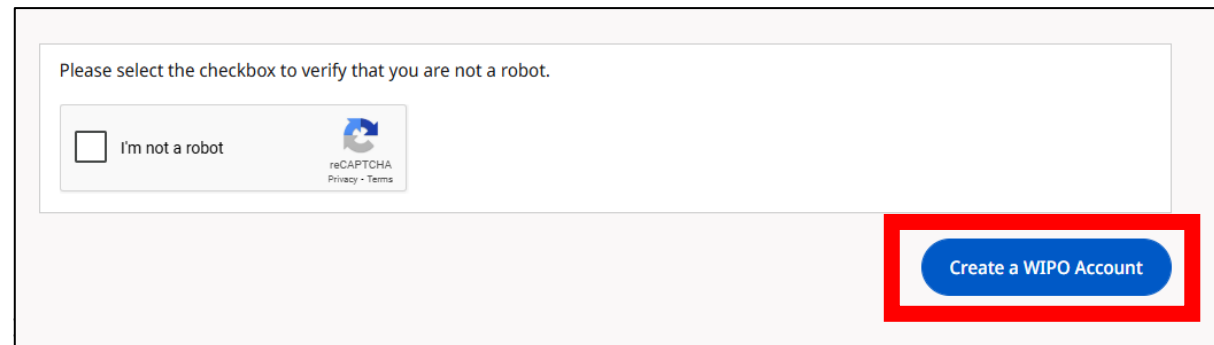
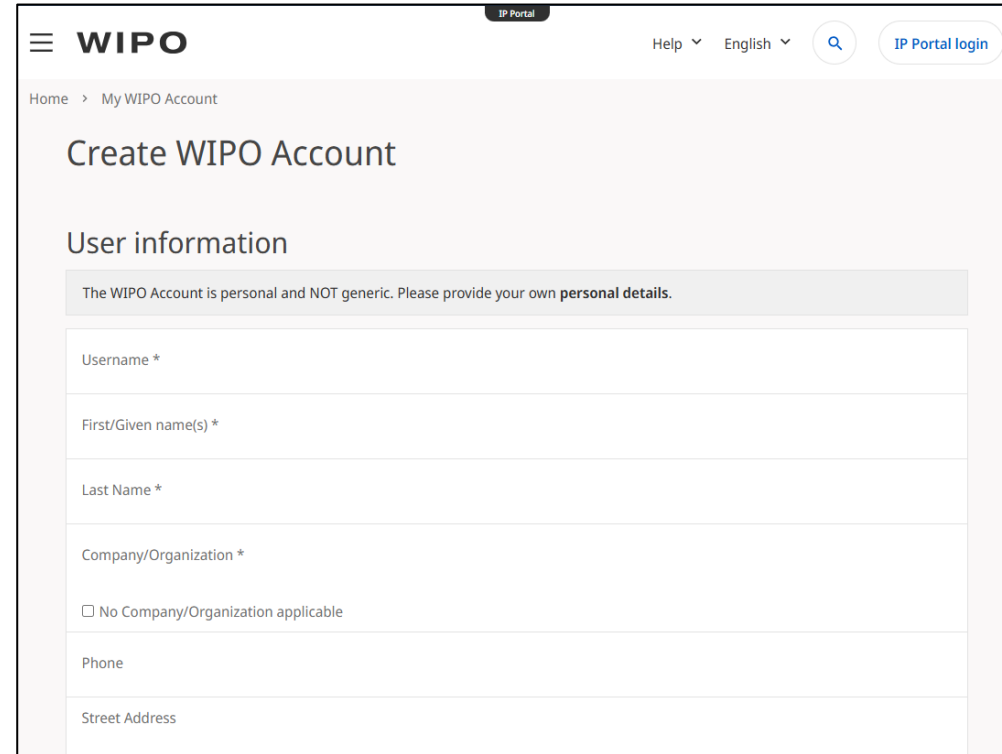

A. Create a WIPO account *(for first time users)*

1. Open the WIPO user center link in your browser -
<https://www3.wipo.int/wipoaccounts/en/generic/public/register.xhtml>
2. Fill in your details and click on “Create a WIPO Account”.
3. Check your registered email ID and click “Validate WIPO Account” in the email received on the registered email.

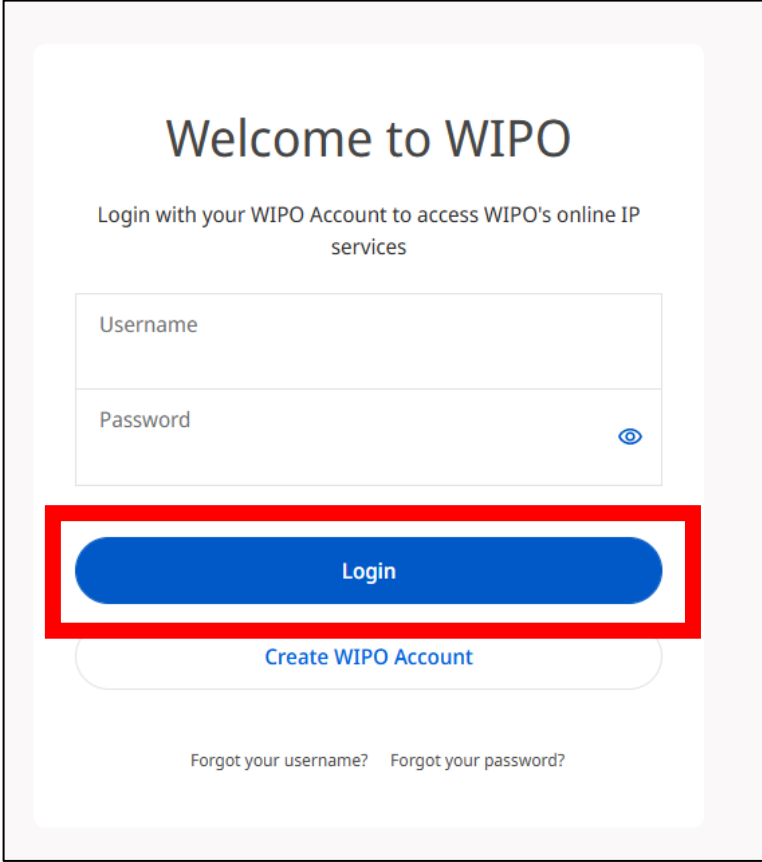

This Program adopts a curriculum-based, blended learning approach that combines multiple modes of learning across distinct phases of distance learning, in-class workshops and, professional work-product assessments.

 - Check that “Your Professional Details” section are up-to-date and correct
 - Select your applicable TISC Agency and TISC Institution using the drop-down menus

NB If your TISC Institution is not in the drop-down menu above, select ‘other’ and enter the details manually. The application will be on hold until the TISC institution is added to the TISC directory — contact your national TISC focal point to request this update and ensure enrollment eligibility.
